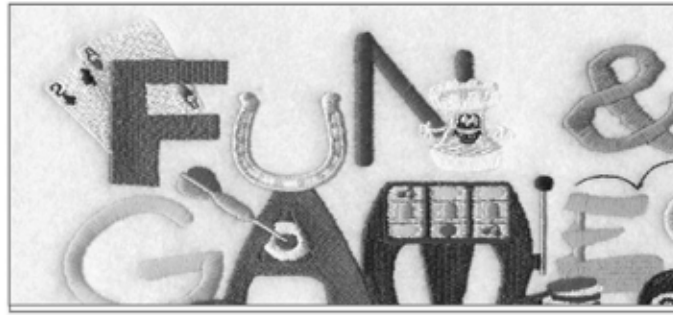

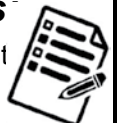

Thank you for the parcels, which arrived at BDSC (Baghdad Diplomatic Support Center), Iraq on 24 August 2025 and were opened and distributed by Red Cross Volunteers.

The joy on their faces to receive the CDs, DVDs, snacks and books was wonderful to see because there had not been any mail delivery for a few weeks.

My apologies that I did not take a photo of those service members who unpacked the boxes.

I do have a request. Inside the boxes were calling cards by Cell Phones for Soldiers, which are not applicable here. I will be returning them to you to pass them along.

We do not have a DVD player and a very small space within the Red Cross Office for tv/video watching. With respect, may we not have any more DVD/CDs sent? Apparently, the one DVD player we had was plugged into a 220V outlet without a transformer because a new person did not see it was 110V.

Thank you for sending us the boxes. We do not want you to think we don't appreciate the generosity of the donors, we have limited space and the ability to watch and listen to DVD/CDs.

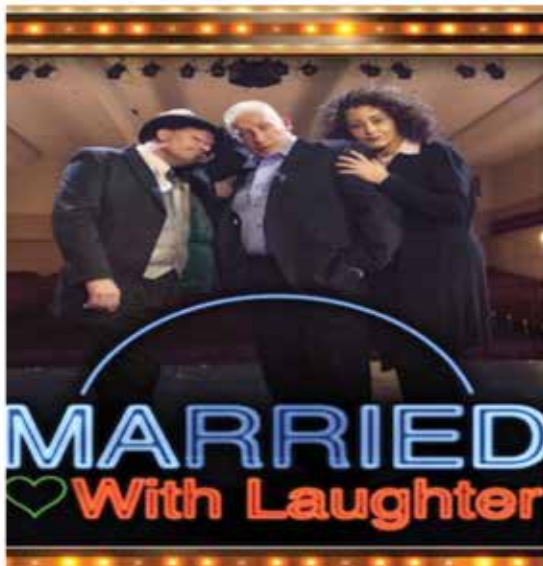

- Vehicle access to the hospital campus from Hospital Drive will be closed. All vehicle traffic will be redirected to the hospital's Route 37 West entrance, located by Riverwood Plaza.
- The Main Entrance Lobby will be accessible 5 am – 8 pm, 7 days a week, but only open to pedestrian traffic (those walking from 9 Hospital Drive or the bus stop).
- Outpatient Lobby hours will expand to 5 am – 8 pm, 7 days a week.
- Visitors or patients picking up or dropping off will need to use the Outpatient Lobby for entry and exit.
- There are no changes to parking for patients and visitors – please continue to use our new Visitor Parking Garage.

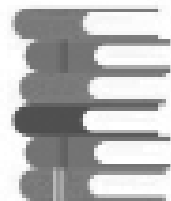

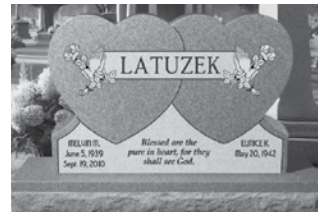

Absolutely **NO** exterior additions, changes, or alterations of any kind can be made until the plans and specifications showing all details are submitted to the Code Committee and approved by the Board.

If plans are within the guidelines of our By-Laws, an approval letter will be prepared and given to the homeowner and submitted to the Zoning Board Officer of Berkeley Township to obtain a permit, if needed.

This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowners' Association or without a permit. ***FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.***

GARBAGE NOTICE

Garbage is **NOT** to be put out to the curb **before 4:00 PM on Mondays**. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: ***The Township has made key changes to trash pickup. All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle. Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.***

***New Year's Eve** – Catered food, music by DJ Adams. \$65 pp. Sponsored by the Social Club. Tickets sales each Friday.

***Murder Mystery Show** - Jan. 17th. \$35 pp. Sponsored by the Men's Club. Drinks, sandwiches and dessert served. BOYB. Tickets sales each Friday.

Volunteers Needed:

*To bake or purchase cookies / cakes for the Christmas tree lighting. Sign-up sheets at the office and on Fridays (during the club ticket sales) and at the main office.

*Bingo Administrator and Volunteers beginning Jan.1, 2026. Larry will show the work that needs to be done. Bingo is very important to our Association. Contact Larry.

Clubs Committee: All of our clubs have merged into 1 committee volunteering to put up (indoor and outdoor) Christmas decorations. (Date not set as of yet.)

New Bus Company: RTC Transportation starts on November 3rd. It will be door-to-door service. They will pick you up and drop you off at your house. Call (between Noon and 8:00 PM), leave a message and they will call you back with a pick-up time for the next day. The driver will carry the package to the front door (only). A rep from the new bus company will come here in the future and talk to the clubs about using their service for trips (casino, Pennsylvania, movies in New York, etc.).

Maintenance Fees: We have collected \$1,410,882 so far. New home buy-in is \$109,864.55. Pool service contract is \$15,645 a year (2-year guaranteed rate contract). Repairing pool leak \$1900, closing is \$2089.73, caulking is \$3190. Bus service \$5000 month, \$22,359 all new gutters and parking lot paving is \$147,000.

Tent: Tent coming down Oct. 16th. Berkley Twp. is taking it and paying to have it taken down and removed from our property. We will then save \$6000.

Morning Homeowner's Mtg. – Will no longer take place, as there are generally only 3-4 people who show up at that time. There will still be the evening homeowner's meeting every 2nd Thursday of each month (unless posted in the Southwind).

Pool Leaks: The detection company located 2 leaks in 2 different skimmers that were then sealed. Caulking will be done within a few weeks and then the cover will be put on.

HOPA Form: Filling out this form keeps our status as an over 55 community with tax breaks. It's done on the odd years. Next, it will be done in 2027. The robocall was to inform residents to get their HOPA form in or you'd been fined. Anyone that did pay a fine early on for 2025, you will be credited for that \$100 fine you paid. No one is going to be fined for 2025. In the first quarter of 2027 you'll fill out your HOPA form. If you've not paid by the end of the first quarter, you will be getting a letter and you will be fined. We will have a robocall sent out as a reminder. *If you are due to fill one out in 2026, you must also fill it out in 2027. Unsure? Check with our office.*

Robocalls: Some landlines have on spam blockers and do not receive our messages. Check with your phone provider or program the office telephone number into your phone. A new system is presently being implemented which should elevate these problems. A voice recording will be sent opposed to a typed message. Any further problems, check with Missy in the office.

Keyboard Bullies: Social media is now out of control and keyboard bullies are attacking the Board with vicious, personal comments and misinformation. Bring your grievances and/or your comments to the Board in the office or at the meetings.

Pool Concerns: A resident questioned why the pool could not stay open for another week in Sept. The Board set the date (opening & closing) earlier in the year. Another resident asked if playing board games around the pool this winter will be allowed. It will be allowed after the cover is installed.

Southwind Ads: A resident heard a rumor that movie ads had to be paid for. Movie ads are free, but any editorial comments are not allowed.

Facebook Forum Page: A resident questioned why a Facebook page is called HCS Forum and that a resident is not allowed to use the word forum or take the title of the association on their own. They were informed the only HCS site is: HCSNJ.org. Another resident questioned the Forum and wants others to stop putting things on social media and for everyone to get along.

400 Club: Had a fully packed dance that was well received.

Petition Circulated: A petition is being circulated for the removal of a Trustee. There was a disagreement between the resident with the petition and a Trustee regarding others signing the petition.

Ceramics: A resident inquired about getting the use of ceramics back in the clubhouse. An instructor would be needed. Pricing for the items and classes was discussed.

The meeting was officially closed.

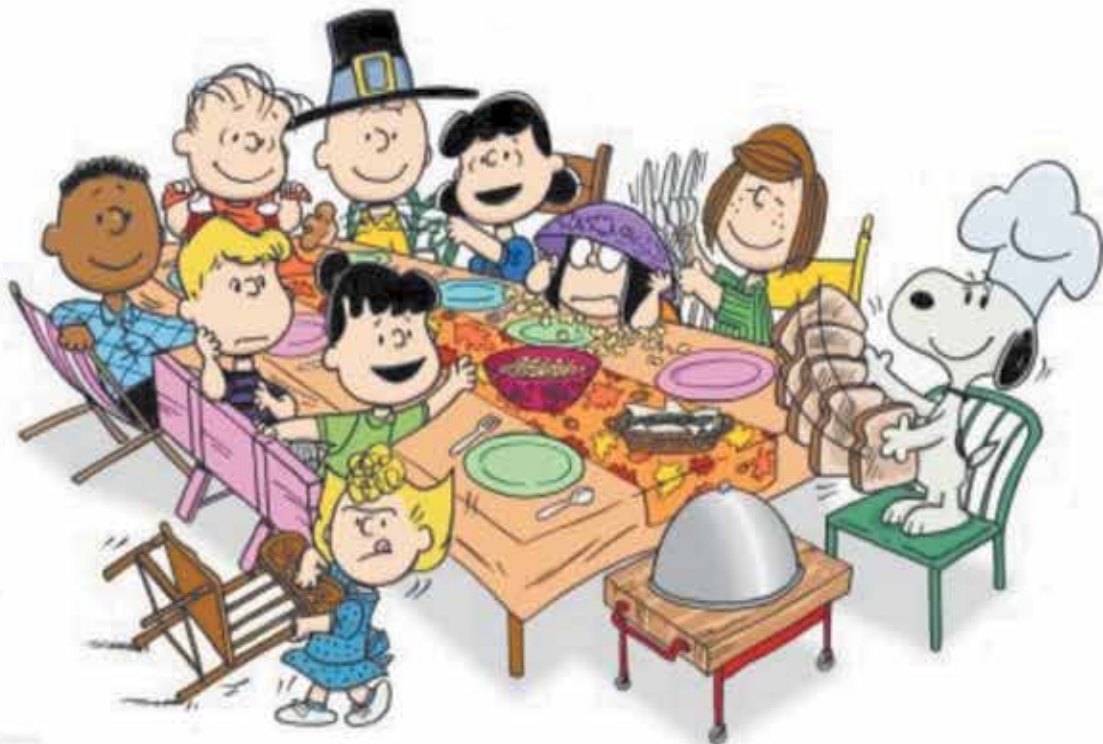

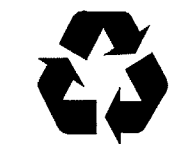

Old-Fashioned Soft Pumpkin Cookies

Ingredients:

2 c. all-purpose flour
1 large egg
1 tsp. ground cinnamon
1/2 tsp. ground nutmeg
3 tablespoons milk
2 c. powdered sugar, sifted
1 c. 100% Pure Pumpkin

1 tsp. baking soda
1 tsp. baking powder
1/2 tsp. salt
1/2 c. softened butter
1 1/2 c. granulated sugar
1 tablespoon butter, softened
2 tsp. vanilla extract, divided

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350° F. Grease baking sheets.

Combine flour, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg and salt in a medium bowl. Beat sugar and 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter in large mixer bowl until well blended. Beat in pumpkin, egg and 1 teaspoon vanilla extract until smooth. Gradually beat in flour mixture. Drop by rounded tablespoon onto prepared baking sheets.

Bake for 15 to 18 minutes or until the edges are firm. Cool on baking sheets for 2 minutes; remove to wire racks to cool completely.

Combine sifted powdered sugar, milk, 1 tablespoon butter and 1 teaspoon remaining vanilla extract in small bowl until smooth. Drizzle over cookies.

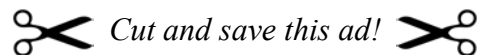

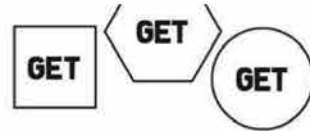
