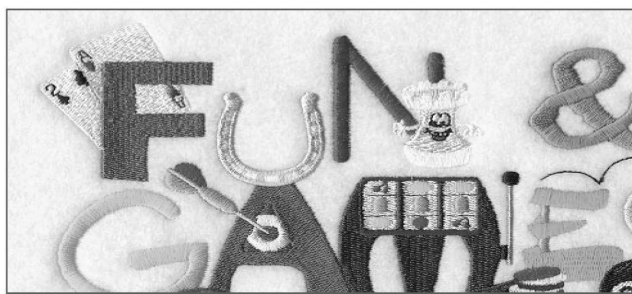

Question on the Election Ballot – June 17, 2026

A resolution was approved by the Board of Trustees on March 26, 2026. The resolution was passed by the Board in an effort to provide better representation from your elected Trustees. A summary of the resolution requires in person attendance by an elected Trustee at a minimum of 21 executive meetings or 91% of the 24 scheduled executive meetings during a physical year. It would also require in person attendance of an elected Trustee at a minimum of 8 homeowner's meetings or 80% of the 10 monthly homeowner's meetings during a physical year. An exception from the in-person requirements would be excused absences due to medical or family issues, approved by the Board of Trustees. Once the resolution is approved by the membership, under the guidelines of the Radburn Act (N.J.A.C. 5:20 effective 7/2017), the resolution will be registered with the Ocean County Clerk and officially become part of the HCS Bylaws. The adoption of this resolution by the membership will provide better and more efficient representation from your elected Trustees.

We are approaching our election day for Trustees on June 17, 2026. We look forward to seeing all members (that are in good standing) participate in the election process.

The election will be held in Building C, for those who wish to vote in person by voting machine. The vote count will be conducted in Building C auditorium by our Election Committee.

If you cannot vote in person and wish to vote, please contact the clubhouse office to sign for and obtain an absentee ballot and the instructions. Absentee ballots will only be given in person to the individual and not for someone else. To ensure that your absentee ballot is counted, it should be returned on or before June 11, 2026, before 5:00 P.M. Please see this month's Southwind for details regarding candidate(s) and election requirements.

Although there are (4) four available seats, I will impress upon you that your vote is important!

So, please vote for the candidate(s) to become your Trustees: (2) candidates – 3 yr. term, (1) candidate – 2 yr. term and (1) candidate – 1 year term. The two highest votes serve the three-year term. The seats will be determined by the amount of votes that the top (4) candidates receive.

We hope to see you on Election Day. Stay safe and healthy.

NOTICE/CALL FOR CANDIDATES - HOLIDAY CITY SOUTH HOMEOWNERS CORP.

Dear Homeowner,

On the advice of our Legal Counsel, Becker LLP, we will be following the provisions set forth in the Radburn Act which requires that we send out this "Call/Notice for Candidates" for the 4 seats that will become available on the Board of Trustees and be decided on our proposed Election Day, **June 17, 2026**.

Our Master Deed/Declaration (Covenants and Restrictions) and By-Laws indicate that we are currently approaching our annual election period. The candidate(s) meeting (s) which allow candidates to speak to the members, is held on the 2nd Thursday of May (14th) and June (11th). The Homeowner's Meeting scheduled for those days will begin at 6:00 PM in the clubhouse. These meetings will be abbreviated business meetings in order to give the membership the opportunity to hear from the candidate vying for the 4 available seats on the Board of Trustees. The Election Committee will gather the data necessary to begin the election process and will oversee it in accordance with the timeline posted in the Southwind. ***Voting will be permitted in person or by Absentee ballot.***

For you to become a candidate, you must be in good standing (which means that any fees associated with your account must be paid in full prior to running for the Board of Trustees) and be a permanent resident for 9 months prior to the date of submission of nomination. The 2 candidates with the most votes will serve on the Board of Trustees for three (3) year terms. The next lowest will serve a (2) year term and the lowest of the (4) vacant seats will serve (1) year.

While the By-laws explain the powers and duties of the Board of Trustees, I would like to briefly highlight some of the responsibilities your Board of Trustees have, so that you may further understand the Trustee position and its importance to you as a homeowner. The Board of Trustees has the responsibility for the operation, care, upkeep and maintenance of the facilities, contract negotiation, insurance for the Association and maintenance of reserve funds. Additionally, information gathered from reserve studies compiled by the Association's Engineering Firm assists in preparation of the annual budget and is collated, then discussed with our Certified Public Accountant (CPA) to determine the Association's financial standing. The Board is also responsible for adjusting or increasing any annual assessments and also calling for special assessments, as the Board deems necessary. These matters are discussed with our CPA, Legal Counsel and voted on by the members of the Board. There are also the many additional responsibilities concerning the daily operation of our homeowner's association. Our Board of Trustees is made up of homeowners who manage the Association's facilities and are fiduciarily responsible with the membership's best interest in mind. The current Board are all members of the Senior Coalition in Berkeley Township, HOA Leader and CAI (Community Association Institute). These are organizations that provide information on current and upcoming legislation and education in the managing of an HOA. To provide the best service to our community continuing education and awareness is part of the responsibility. If you are interested in becoming a candidate for the Board of Trustees, please fill out the form and return it to the Clubhouse with a clear photo no later than 2:00 PM on 4/6/26.

Memorandum: Board meeting with Legal Counsel regarding the 2026

Election Date: April & May

Timeline:

5/8/2026 - A Notice of Delinquency will be mailed out to all delinquent (over 30 days) homeowners. Homeowners who are not delinquent as of the 9th will not receive this notice.

5/8/2026 - Close of business (2PM). All supporting documents (i.e. death certificates, Powers of Attorney and deeds) must be presented to Office Staff. After this date, no records will be accepted and votes will be assigned as either one-half or a whole vote. This date will be the record date for the election.

6/11/2026 – Absentee ballot must be submitted by 5PM (close of business).

6/17/2026 - 11AM to 7PM voting will be open. There will be at least one individual (a gatekeeper) with the Association's computer system, to determine if a voter is eligible to vote and if so, whether a half or whole vote will be provided to the unit owner(s). At 7PM, the tallying will commence with the Election Committee overseeing the vote as in the past. One observer will be permitted in the front row and all other homeowners present must remain quiet to permit tallying.

4/6/2026 – Return of Nominations

5/8/2026 – Good Standing Date for Nominations

5/8/2026 – Notice to be mailed to Members not in “Good Standing”.

5/26/2026 - Record date homeowner must be in good standing to vote

6/11/2026 – Absentee Ballots Due 5PM

6/17/2026 – Election

Members who are not in “good standing” must be notified by the Association a minimum of 30 days prior to the election, that they are not in good standing. Such notice shall state the reason why the resident is not in good standing. The notice shall state that residents have the right to contest the board’s determination by requesting Alternative Dispute Resolution. Residents shall be allowed to rectify their standing up until 5 business days prior to the election date. The ADR notice should state that they have 10 days to request ADR or it is waived.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:26-8.8(c), an Owner is deemed to be in “good standing” if they, “(1) are current in the payment of common expenses, late fees, interest on unpaid assessments, legal fees, or other charges lawfully assessed; (2) are in compliance with a judgment for common expenses, late fees, interest on unpaid assessments, legal fees, or other charges lawfully assessed; (3) are in full compliance with a settlement agreement with respect to the payments of assessments, legal fees, or other charges lawfully assessed; (4) have requested or are participating in Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) or in a court proceeding for a dispute over a matter that affects the owner’s good standing.”



Questions about Social Media and the Truth

The purpose of this message is to provide the general membership with information verified by the Board of Trustees, information found to be correct and truthful. The Board recently reviewed a message that was posted on social media from an unreliable source, a source that seems to have one purpose, to defame the Board of Trustees (with a focus on certain Board members). They are doing this by supplying information on social media that has not been verified and has been proven unreliable. The message in question was a recent post (to a site that has proven to be unreliable) implying that our members who work as Security Guards were not trained under the New Jersey State Police (NJSP) SORA program. This is a program that licenses Security Officers in the State of NJ. The truth of the matter is a key element that differentiates between “Security Officers” and “Security Guards”. Security Officers are those individuals who would act in a law enforcement capacity and are required to be licensed by NJSP under SORA. Security Guards are employed privately with no intent to act in a law enforcement capacity, such as ours, and are not required to be licensed under SORA. The uneducated and misinformed statement by the administrators of the social media site apparently had the intent to either remove our Security Guard Staff and/or cost the Association an extra expense by having them unnecessarily trained. The Board of Trustees acknowledges that our members appreciate the presence of the Security staff for reasons of safety, especially for the members who walk out to their vehicle after evening functions. We wish to let the membership know that we intend to keep the Security Guard staff on in their current capacity.

This issue as well as many other posts on unauthorized social media sites spew misinformation and tend to cause dissension among our members providing no useful/reliable source of information. Let’s speak to the method these site use to filter and skew the narrative so that they appear to be “all knowing”. For many months these sites have been observed, and it has become very apparent that when someone posts a statement related to the Board, appearing to be of a positive nature, the administrator of the site takes it down or blocks the individual(s) posting. A perfect example of that is the recent post of incorrect information regarding our Security Guards. When questioned – the individuals who questioned were blocked. This is nothing more than “selective enforcement” of individuals rights and violates freedom of speech (which is our Constitutional right). We can site many more incidents that reflect the controlling nature of the administrators of these sites and their followers, all of which appear to be nothing more than “cyber bullying” from behind a keyboard. In their eyes it appears to be ok for certain individuals to use their creative skills to demeane others and create disdain based on untruths, while refusing to let members respond and speak the truth.

We would like to remind our membership that our governing documents are in place for a reason and allow for many questions to be answered. Also, there are other venues where correct information can be found: our official web page, the Southwind, homeowner’s meetings and/or at the office/trustee rooms. The members of your Board of Trustees are and continue to work diligently to provide the community with amenities that have been requested as well as answer questions related to the day-to-day operations of the association.

More importantly, don’t let your opinions be swayed by incorrect and/or inaccurate information provided by person(s) who wish to control a narrative and end up providing inaccurate/false information. Also remember that these same individuals are attempting to skew the thought process of members in an attempt to gain a controlling interest of your Board of Trustees. Should that happen, it would lead to a select few controlling the amenities and the finances of the association. The few that appear to have their own interest at the center of their motives – not the benefit of the entire community. As always, we can only hope that when information is skewed, manipulated and controlled for the benefit of the few, intelligent individuals will see through the disguise and the truth will prevail.

We will close for now, but we are sure you can expect additional messages like these in the future, as we are sure the inaccurate social media posts will continue. Just remember, attend the Homeowner’s meeting or stop by the office if you want accurate information from a reliable source – your Board of Trustees and the supporting staff.

If plans are within the guidelines of our By-Laws, a form will be filled out by the homeowner so they can submit it to the Zoning Board Officer of Berkeley Township, to obtain a permit if needed.

This pertains to any changes, additions, or alterations on the exterior of the home - roof, siding, paint, driveway, patio, sheds, etc.

Absolutely **NO WORK** can be started without permission from the Homeowner's Association or without a permit. **FINES WILL BE IMPOSED if this is not adhered to.**

GARBAGE NOTICE

Garbage is **NOT** to be put out to the curb **before 4:00 PM on Mondays**. This is a Berkeley Township Ordinance and HCS residents must comply. Violators may be issued a fine for non-conformance by the Township and/or HCS. Trash receptacles must be kept in your garage, behind your home, or in an area out of view from the street. Receptacles must be covered and concealed. If you are away, consider having a friend or neighbor place your garbage cans at the curb and return them to their respective out-of-view locations after trash pickup.

With the outbreak of the **COVID-19 virus**, Berkeley Sanitation Department's rules for putting out trash is as follows: ***The Township has made key changes to trash pickup. All household trash must be bagged and placed in an outdoor trash receptacle. Sanitation employees will not pick up trash that is not bagged.***

The speed limit is **25 MPH** in residential areas. Those of you who have children living with you and who have the privilege of living here in our 55+ community are racing through our streets. TREES IN THE COMMUNITY

Recently we have had several severe storms. Many of us have had tree limbs and or trees fall. The rule of thumb regarding these fallen trees and/or tree limbs is simple. If a tree or tree limb(s) that are in the common area fall in the common area, we leave the downed tree and/or tree limbs where they fall, unless they are creating a hazard. If a tree or tree limbs from the common area fall onto a member's property, the association will remove them. If a tree and /or tree limb do damage to a homeowner's home, they will have to file through their homeowner's insurance for damages, but the association will have the tree and/or tree limbs removed. Also, if the downed tree and/or tree limbs from a tree are from one that stood on the homeowner's property or the township right of way, the homeowner has responsibility for any damage they may cause. This should clarify the association policy for downed trees and/or tree limbs. If a homeowner has a tree on their property and would like to have it removed and are not sure if that tree is on their property for sure, please call the Code Committee and have them come check on it before removing anything. Berkeley Township requires that you have a permit to remove trees.
